REGISTRATION:

Registration for this event is an online submission and must be completed in full, including payment, for the entry to be finalized.

CLOSING DATE:

Access to online registration will cease at **10:00 pm** on **August 30, 2017.**

Registrations will be accepted on a **first come - first serve basis** with restrictions in certain categories to accommodate the scheduling of categories. Please review your entry information before submitting.

CATEGORIES:

All competitive categories (Singles, Dance and Pair) will be combined categories only **including** Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile Dance
All drawn groups are final and cannot be changed.

The following categories are to be held at the Skate Ontario Octoberfest 2017:

SENIOR

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Dance	Short & Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Must have passed the complete Gold Dance test. No age requirement.

JUNIOR

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. Shall meet ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Dance	Short & Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Must have passed the complete Gold Dance test or higher. Shall meet ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.

NOVICE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. Shall be under the age of 17 before July 1, 2017.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirements.
Dance	Pattern & Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Must have passed at least 2 pattern dances from the Gold Dance test or higher. Woman shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2017. Men shall be under the age of 21 before, July 1, 2017 (Cha Cha Congelado & Argentine Tango)

PRE-NOVICE

Singles/Pair	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test.
Dance	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test or higher.
Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2017
Pair	Short & Free offered as a combined category only. Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2017
Dance	Pattern & Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2017 (Rocker Foxtrot & Paso Doble)

JUVENILE

Singles/Pair	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test or higher.
Dance	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test or higher.
Women/Men (U12)	Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2017
Women/Men (U14)	Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2017

Pair	Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2017
Dance	Pattern & Free Dance offered as combined categories only. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2017 (Willow Waltz & Keats Foxtrot)

PRE-JUVENILE

Singles/Pair	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Free Skate test or higher.
Dance	Must have passed the complete Junior Bronze Dance test or higher.
Women/Men (U11)	Shall be under the age of 11 before July 1, 2017
Women/Men (U13)	Shall be under the age of 13 before July 1, 2017
Pair	Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2017
Dance	Pattern & Free Dance offered as combined categories only. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2017 (Swing & Willow Waltz)

SOLO SHORT DANCE

Open	Open to athletes who are under the age of 21 as of July 1, 2017 Must have passed the complete Senior Silver Dance test Specified Pattern Dance Rhythm: Cha Cha Optional Second Rhythm: Rhumba, Salsa, Mambo, Meringue, Bachata and any closely related Latin American Rhythm

ENTRY FEES

Payable by VISA or MasterCard only. No other form of payment will be accepted.

SINGLES:

\$120.00 per person for Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile categories and Solo Short Dance

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information and payment is complete. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a \$50.00 late fee.

REFUNDS AND WITHDRAWALS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. If an entry is withdrawn prior to **August 30, 2017**, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$35.00 per skater) will be granted. NOTE: NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be granted after **August 30, 2017**.

RESTRICTIONS: In the case of a very large entry in any category, the entries will be drawn into groups. All drawn groups are final and cannot be changed. Singles skaters are permitted to enter only one singles category. Dance & Pair skaters are permitted to enter only one category of a similar type, i.e. one long program + one short program, or one pattern/short + one free dance.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As on July 1, 2017.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Registration and music registration will commence one hour prior to the first category of the day. Each competitor will receive an accreditation tag that must be retained and used as a pass for the duration of the competition. All skaters MUST have their music and planned program content sheet when registering. All Ontario Coaches must carry their Skate Ontario Coach Accreditation Tag. Out of province coaches must provide proof that they are a registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing.

MUSIC: Each entry must provide two CDs of the correct music for the competition upon registration, one for competition - marked "Master" and one for back up - marked "Copy". These must be registered with music registration at least one hour prior to the posted start time of the category and may not be removed for any reason until after the category is completed. CD Audio Discs are the only music format accepted. iPhones, iPods or other digital sources will not be accepted as backups. Music must be picked up within 30 minutes after completion of the category.

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the performing rights societies. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from the performing rights societies.

Standard Specifications for Music:

- (1) Only one program shall be recorded on each CD
- (2) Competitor's name followed by home club, category, program type-short or free and music time shall be printed on front of the CD label using a black Sharpie pen
- (3) Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case in good repair marked with the skater's name, home club, category, program type – short or free, and total music time

Technical Guidelines for Music CDs:

- (1) Music on CD must be burned in CD Audio Format (NOT mp3;.acc or DVD)
- (2) Music should be burned on CD-R discs of good quality that provide legible space for the skater information to be printed on
- (3) It is recommended that CDs be burned at speeds 16Xs or less
- (4) Skater or Team should keep a set of CDs for COMPETITION USE ONLY. It is recommended that this set be used for each competition unless the music has been changed

Pre-Novice and Novice Dance competitors: The ISU pattern dance music to be used for all events is the 2001 Revised Version produced by the ISU.

AWARDS: Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded for each category. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at the Skate Ontario Octoberfest 2017, coaches must be Primary STARSkate trained or Region Coach in Training or higher. Coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coaches' Accreditation Tag. These tags will be available at the coaches' registration table for any coaches who have not yet received them. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.
